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### Certified Clinical Documentation Specialist Candidate

Candidates for certification must list their clinical documentation specialist experience. Applications may be audited to verify work history and educational background, credentials, and licensure. Once a candidate has accumulated the time as a clinical documentation specialist, it does not expire for the purposes of applying for certification.

Candidates have three months/90 days from the date their name is submitted to PSI to schedule and take their exam. Examination fee. The fee for the certification application process and examination is \$255 for ACDIS members and \$355 for non-members. ### About CCDS Certification | ACDIS

You may be able to obtain a position as a clinical documentation specialist with either a postsecondary certificate or associate's degree. In general, course topics in certificate programs will include anatomy and physiology, classification and coding systems, medical terminology and healthcare statistics.

### How Can I Become a Clinical Documentation Specialist?

Position description. The Clinical Documentation Integrity (CDI) Specialist is accountable for reviewing patient medical records in the inpatient and/or outpatient setting to capture accurate representation of the severity of illness and facilitate proper coding. The CDI Specialist validates that coding reflects medical necessity of services and facilitates appropriate coding which provides an accurate reflection and reporting of the severity of the patient's illness along with expected risk ...

Certified Healthcare Documentation Specialist. The Certified Healthcare Documentation Specialist (CHDS) exam is based on the AHDI Medical Transcriptionist Job Descriptions and the competencies outlined in the AHDI Core Competencies and the AHDI Model Curriculum. It is a voluntary credentialing exam for individuals who wish to become Certified Healthcare Documentation Specialists.

### Certified Healthcare Documentation Specialist ...

Hold an associate's degree or higher; or. Hold a CCS®, CCS-P®, RHIT®, or RHIA® credential. While not required, the following are recommended: Minimum of two (2) years of clinical documentation integrity experience. Associate's degree or higher in a health care or allied health care discipline.

### Certified Documentation Improvement Practitioner (CDIP ...

To become a clinical documentation specialist, you can become certified through either the Association of Clinical Documentation Integrity Specialists (ACDIS), featuring certifications for entry-level employees, or the clinical documentation improvement practitioner course of study via the American Health Information Management Association (AHIMA).
